

## From The South West

From M5: Leave M5 at Junction 18A, follow M49 motorway until it joins M4 (1<sup>st</sup> exit of roundabout). Cross the 2<sup>nd</sup> Severn Bridge (Toll-cash only) continue on the M4 until J24, leave the motorway and take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit of the roundabout (A449), signposted The Midlands M50. Continue on this road (which becomes the A40) through Monmouth and take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit of the roundabout. After the village of Whitchurch you will see a disused roadside restuarant on your left, you need to turn off just after it unto the A4137 to Hereford. Continue on this road until you come to a T-junction where this road meets the A49. You need to turn left unto the A49 towards Hereford. Continue on this road through Harewood End and Much Birch, after a straight and at the top of Callow Hill you will see a turn on your right for Kingsthorne, immediately after that there is a left turn to Callow which you need to take. Follow this road until you come to a T-junction where the road meets the A465. You need to turn left here towards Abergavenny and then take the 2<sup>nd</sup> right unto the B4349 to Hay-on-Wye. Continue to follow this road (don't turn off to Kingstone) through Clehonger and to Madley. In the village of Madley you will see the Church on your left and then the Red Lion pub on your right, take the next right (signposted Bridge Sollars). The cottage is 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway on your left about half a mile from Madley.
